

### What is a reverse bid ?

- This is a rebid at the 2 level (or higher) of a higher ranking suit than the first bid.

For example:

1♦ - 1♠  
2♥

- It shows 16+ points and is forcing for at least 1 round
- Responder decides were to go after that

### What is a reverse bid ?

- Bidding the same suit or a lower ranking suit at the lowest possible level, is showing less than 16. For example:

1♦ - 1♠ or 1♦ - 1♠  
2♦ 2♣

- If you have 16+ and your other suit is a lower ranking suit, you must jump. eg

1♦ - 1♠  
3♣

### What is a reverse bid ?

- Bidding a higher ranking suit at the one level is not a reverse. For example:

1♦ - 1♥  
1♠

- This must be a shapely minimum hand as Opener did not open 1NT or rebid 1NT

### What is a reverse bid ?

- With the following two hands, you open 1♣ and partner bids 1♠

- What is your next bid ?

1	♠ A 3	2	♠ A 3
	♥ K 10 6 3		♥ K 10 6 3
	♦ K 4 <b>2♥</b>		♦ K 4 <b>2♣</b>
	♣ A Q 7 6 5		♣ A 7 6 5 2

### What is a reverse bid ?

- With this hand you open 1♣ with and partner bids 1♦

- What is your next bid ?

♠ A 9 8 7  
♥ A K  
♦ A J  
♣ A 9 8 7 4

**3♠**

Why not 2♠?

This hand cannot open with 2NT or 2C, so the 1C then the double jump shows the points and now by inference it is a shapely hand
