

With W in 6 hearts, lead was the ♠8. Declarer ruffed the second round and considered his options. There are 11 tricks and a twelfth may come from diamonds. The problem is, three entries to dummy (QJ of H and king of C) are not enough to ruff diamonds three times and take advantage of a 4-3 break in the suit.

Consider your alternatives before you play. The best plan is to run your long suit, putting your opposition under pressure by giving them two choices of discards. By running a long suit, opposition are in the situation of setting up winners for you.
